

TERMS TO KNOW

ACTIVE MEMBER: a member who has gone through the Initiation Ceremony and met all requirements

BETA PI CHAPTER #64: the chapter located at the University of Akron and Kent State University

BIG SIS: an active member, chosen by a pledge member, who serves as a role model and helps them with anything they may need (the pledge member is called the Little Sis)

INSPIRATION WEEK: a period of time in which events are held for the pledges by the active members, which is concluded with the Initiation Ceremony

MANDATORY CHAPTER EVENTS: events that all members, actives and pledges, must attend

MERIT SYSTEM: a system that monitors the attendance of all members and awards points for those in attendance

PENGUIN PAL: an active member, assigned to a pledge, who writes letters, sends gifts, and gives support. Revealed during I-week

PLEDGE EDUCATOR: an active member who helps with the entire pledge period for all pledges, leads meetings, teaches history of the Sorority and chapter, and answers any and all questions that the pledges may have. She prepares the pledges to become active members

PLEDGE MEMBER: a member who has not gone through Initiation
